



**“Imparting a Legacy – Man Up by Slowing Down”**  
2 Timothy 3: 10 – 17

As we observe from today’s text, the apostle Paul (as a spiritual father) imparts of a Legacy to Timothy (as a spiritual son). *How did Paul empowered by the Spirit do this?* He ‘slowed down’ to focus on the relationship with Timothy, not many projects to accomplish.

Paul’s relationship with Timothy is insightful for today, for Timothy did not have a father present in his life. This text addresses *the downstream problem of fatherlessness* by the upstream solution of Spirit-empowered discipleship. It’s an imperative for today’s father and mentors to ‘Slow down’ by taking time to invest relationally with Jesus’ love into children.

**Let’s notice Several key points of Imparting Gospel Legacy observed from Paul in his mentorship with Timothy:**

**1. – SLOW DOWN to \_\_\_\_\_ about Life’s Most Important Matters. – Vs. 10,11**

The Challenge from Paul’s Spirit-empowered Example is to *share vulnerably with ‘near ones’ in the following areas :*

Why is Imparting Life so important?
