



“TOGETHER... Let’s Pray” Hebrews 4: 14 – 16

As you read through the book of Hebrews, you will find 14 x’s the phrase “LET US” is used by the Holy Spirit to call us together for action. These texts are called the ‘exhortation passages;’ Exhortations are *action requests* to move the ‘hearer’ to action based on truth to deepen closeness to God and one another.

The ‘Let Us’ texts clearly communicate the truth – “Life was not meant be lived alone, but in community with fellow believers” So let’s observe the first 2 of the 14 “Let us” texts of Hebrews this morning.

Consider Several Exhortations based on the Exegesis of the Text –

1 – TOGETHER Let’s _____.

Praying Together is Powerful – see Matt. 18: 19 – 20

Praying Together builds Unity – see Jude 20 – 21

Praying Together removes aloneness.

2 – TOGETHER Let’s Discover _____.

Place of Grace – God’s throne room!

Provisions of Grace – see Isaiah 30: 18

People of Grace – see Hebrews 3: 5, 14

3 – TOGETHER Let's Listen to & Yield to _____.

Look to the Church of Antioch in [Acts 13: 1 – 3](#) as an example.

God spoke as a powerful outcome of the people's prayer. – see [13: 2](#)

God spoke in an UNEXPECTED WAY. – *“Separate to Me Saul & Barnabas for the work to which I have called them.”*

- Not a LOSING of these leaders, but a LAUNCHING of workers.
