## Bible Scripture Passage: Isaiah 6:1-8 (Isaiah's Vision)

6 In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple. <sup>2</sup> Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. <sup>3</sup> And one called out to another and said, "Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts, The whole earth is full of His glory."

<sup>4</sup> And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke. <sup>5</sup> Then I said, "Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts." <sup>6</sup> Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. <sup>7</sup> He touched my mouth with it and said, "Behold, this has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven."

<sup>8</sup> Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

## Worship Cycle Three: Confession: The lost element of worship.

- Confession happens when we <u>see our sins</u> like God <u>sees our sins</u>. Psalm 103; Psalm 51:10, 12-13, 15
- Confession is the foundation of true redemption.

  - We need a fresh glimpse of God's grace.
  - We need a fresh touch of God's grace.
  - We need our vision <u>corrected</u> by the grace of God.
