#### Matthew 5:1-12: The Sermon on the Mount

**5** "Seeing the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and when he sat down, his disciples came to him. <sup>2</sup> And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying: <sup>3</sup> "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. <sup>4</sup> "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted. <sup>5</sup> "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth. <sup>6</sup> "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied. <sup>7</sup> "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy. <sup>8</sup> "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God. <sup>9</sup> "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. <sup>11</sup> "Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. <sup>12</sup> Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

#### "Blessed are those who <u>hunger and thirst</u> for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied."

### "Hunger and thirst for righteousness"...

**Psalm 42:1-2**: "As the deer pants for the water brooks, so my soul pants for You, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God; When shall I come and appear before God?" (NASB)

**Psalm 19:14**: "Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart Be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD, my rock and my Redeemer." (NASB)

• When we believe in Him at salvation, <u>He transferred His righteousness into</u> our life.

Psalms 143:2; Ecclesiastes 7:20; Romans 3:10-12; Hebrews 1:3, 8-9; Romans 5:17-19 (NASB)

• We <u>should pursue His righteousness</u> daily through studying His Word and living out our faith.

Proverbs 21:21: "He who pursues righteousness and loyalty finds life, righteousness, and honor." (NASB)
