John 3:16 (NASB1995): “God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.”

- **God gave...His indescribable gift.** (2 Corinthians 9:15; Isaiah 53:5-6)
- **Because we believe...in Him.** (John 6:27; Romans 10:9-10)
- **We receive...eternal life with Jesus Christ.**

Genuine salvation can never be lost; true believers **will be divinely preserved** and **will faithfully persevere** because they are **kept by God’s divine power**.
