

“What’s Next Message Series: Disciples”

“As Jesus was going down the road, he saw Matthew sitting at his tax-collection booth. ‘Come, be my disciple,’ Jesus said. So Matthew got up and followed him.” – Matthew 9:9 (NLT)



The word disciple means a student, a learner, a pupil, and an apprentice. The early Christians were called disciples before they were called Christians. Before you can be a true mentor, you have to be a disciple first.

A disciple is just somebody who’s being mentored by somebody else.

To be a Disciple of Jesus I must...

1. Be with Him constantly.

“IF you want to be my disciple you must come and follow me, because my servants must be where I am. And IF they follow me, the Father will honor them.” – John 12:26 (NLT)

“The plan was that they would be with him and then he would send them out to proclaim the Word.” – Mark 3:14a (MSG)

2. Love Him supremely.

“IF you want to be my follower you must love me more than your own father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, more than your own life. Otherwise, you cannot be my disciple.” – Luke 14:26 (NLT)

“The most important commandment is this: You must love the Lord your God with ALL your heart, ALL your soul, ALL your mind, and ALL your strength.” – Mark 12:29-30 (NLT)

3. Love the church unconditionally.

“IF you have love for one another, then everyone will know that you are my disciples.” – John 13:35 (TEV)

"This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters." – 1 John 3:16 (NIV)

4. Obey Him continually.

"If you continue to obey my teaching, you are truly my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." – John 8:31-32 (NCV)

"If you continue to live in me and what I say lives in you, then ask for anything you want, and it will be yours. You give glory to my Father when you produce a lot of fruit and therefore show that you are my disciples." – John 15:7-8 (GW)

5. Serve other unselfishly.

"If you want to be the most important person you must take the last place and be a servant to everyone else." – Mark 9:35 (GW)

"For even I, the Son of Man, came here not to be served but to serve others, and to give my life as a ransom for many." – Matthew 20:28 (NLT)

"If anyone wants to be my disciple, he must deny himself, take up his cross and follow me." – Matthew 16:24 (LB)

6. Share Him eagerly.

"Jesus called out to them, 'Come, be my disciples, and I will show you how to fish for people!' And they left their nets at once and went with him." – Matthew 4:20 (LB)

"Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. And teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." – Matthew 28:19-20 (NLT)

A true disciple of Christ is willing to be a disciple-maker of others.

"If you try to keep your life for yourself, you will lose it. But IF you give up your life for my sake and for the sake of the Good News, you will find true life." – Mark 8:35-36 (NLT)
