Jesus came to give authentic peace!

The place of peace is actually a person of peace. The only lasting source of peace is God himself.

How do we discover Authentic Peace...

- I. Where can we go for peace?
 - <u>Spiritual peace</u> is peace with God.

"Therefore, since we have been declared righteous by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" Roman 5:1 (HCSB)

• <u>Emotional peace</u> is the peace of God.

"... since God is not a God of disorder but of peace" 1 Corinthians 14:33 (HCSB)

This peace is not the absence of conflict, but an ability to cope with the conflicts and frustrations of life.

"Don't worry about anything, but in everything, through prayer and petition with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses every thought, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus" Philippians 4:6-7 (HCSB)

"And let the peace of the Messiah, to which you were also called in one body, control your hearts. Be thankful" Colossians 3:15 (HCSB)

II. How do we maintain peace?

"So then, we must pursue what promotes peace and what builds up one another" Romans 14:19 (HCSB)

• If we want peace, we must obey God's Word.

"Abundant peace belongs to those who love Your instruction; nothing makes them stumble...I obey Your decrees and love them greatly" Psalm 119:165, 167 (HCSB)

God with peace comes when we live in harmony with Him - when we do what He tells us to do.

If we want peace, we must focus on God's presence.

"You will keep in perfect peace the mind [that is] dependent [on You], for it is trusting in You "Isaiah 26:3 (HCSB)

• If we want God's peace, we must trust God's purpose.

"Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding; think about Him in all your ways, and He will guide you on the right paths" Proverbs 3:5-6 (HCSB)

If we want God's peace, we need to ask for it.

"Don't worry about anything, but in everything, through prayer and petition with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses every thought, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus" Philippians 4:6-7 (HCSB)
