## THE BENEFITS FROM JESUS' RESURRECTION

### Three Things We Know For Certain

#### 1. Jesus has a great purpose for my life.

“and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf.” 2 Corinthians 5:15 (NASB)

“For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him.” Colossians 1:16 (NASB)

“also we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will, 12. to the end that we who were the first to hope in Christ would be to the praise of His glory.” Ephesians 1:11-12 (NASB)

#### 2. Jesus has a great power for my problems.

“I pray that you will begin to understand how incredibly great God's power really is to help those who believe him. It is that same mighty power that raised Christ from the dead!” Ephesians 1:19-20a (LB)

“By his power God raised the Lord from the dead, and he will also raise us!” 1 Corinthians 6:14 (NIV)

“We were really crushed and overwhelmed, and we feared we would never live through it... We saw how powerless we were to help ourselves; BUT THAT WAS GOOD, for then we put everything into the hands of God, who alone could save us, for he can even raise the dead! And God did help us, and he saved us...and we expect him to do it again and again!” 2 Corinthians 1:8-10 (LB)

### **3. Jesus has a great place for me after I die.**

Now we hope for the blessings God has for his children. These blessings, which cannot be destroyed or be spoiled or lose their beauty, are kept in heaven for you. 5. God's power protects you through your faith until salvation is shown to you at the end of time. 6. This makes you very happy, even though now for a short time different kinds of troubles may make you sad. 1 Peter 1:3-6 (NCV)
